



[NOT ONLY GAMES] JAM COMPETITION TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Entering this competition

1. This competition is operated and run by King.com Limited, a company registered in Malta whose address is Aragon Business Centre, Level 4, Dragonara Road, St Julians STJ3140, Malta with (also referred to in these terms as 'we', 'us', 'our' and "King") in collaboration and support from selected participating Universities in Spain (also referred to in these terms as the "University").
2. By entering this competition you agree that you have read and accept these terms and conditions.
3. You must be at least 18 years of age and either currently studying at university or have graduated from university at the time of entry in order to enter this competition.
4. You must not enter this competition if you or any of your immediate family are an employee, contractor or sub-contractor of King or its associated companies.
5. Only one entry per person is permitted and only one entry per team is permitted. Teams must be between three and five people and must be enrolled at a University or be part of a team where the majority of members are part of a University.
6. You must only submit entries that are your own work.
7. Entries which are corrupt or illegible may not be accepted.
8. We reserve the right to verify any entries and winners and may refuse to reward prizes and/or disqualify you if make or attempt to make any entry to this competition which is in King's reasonable opinion contrary to these terms and conditions or by its nature unfair to other entrants. This might include entries which are made by automated means, fraudulent, made in bulk, made on behalf of another person, or made by hacking, cheating or deception.
9. You must comply with the laws that apply to you in the location that you access our competitions from. If any laws applicable to you restrict or prohibit you from entering our competitions, you must comply with those legal restrictions or, if applicable, refrain from entering our competition.

How to enter

10. This competition consist of two phases:
 - a. Phase I:
 - i. To enter each member of your team must submit their individual details on our portal <https://king.avature.net/notonlygamesjam> along with a link to your team video, which shall detail: (i) your names; (ii) what you study; (iii) the University you represent; (iv) the role each member will have during the competition; and (v) the motivation behind why your team wishes to participate at the [Not Only Gams] Jam event by 23:59 CET on 15th April 2018.
 - ii. By the 23rd April 2018, from all valid entries, the judging panel for the University you are representing shall select two (2) entries which in the opinion of the judging panel has shown the most motivation to participate in the [Not Only Games] Jam event. You and your team shall be notified by e-mail if you are selected to proceed to Phase II.
 - b. Phase II:

- i. Those teams selected to proceed from Phase I, shall be invited to participate in Phase II. To participate in Phase II, you shall be physically required to attend the [Not Only Games] Jam event at Canòdrom Parc de Recerca Creativa, Carrer de Concepció Arenal 165, Barcelona on Friday 11th May 2018 until Sunday 13th May 2018.
 - ii. The [Not Only Games] Jam event shall officially commence at 9:00 CET on Saturday 12th May 2018 and shall close at 12:00 CET on Sunday 13th May 2018. During this period your team shall be given a task around diversity and inclusion in videogames or new digital entertainment technologies, which will be further detailed on the day of the event. Your team must submit your final work, project and files you wish to use to present your project by 12:00 CET on Sunday 13th May 2018 by the method detailed on the day of the event. If you make any entries outside of this period they will not be valid. Your team shall be required to provide a presentation on Sunday 13th May 2018 to the judging panel to allow the judging panel to evaluate your team entry.
 - iii. From all valid entries, the judging panel shall select one (1) team as the winners at around 15:00 CET on Sunday 13th May 2018.
11. You do not have to pay to enter any of our competitions, however you are responsible for any accommodation, travel, food or other charges you may incur in entering and attending the [Not Only Games] Jam event. You shall be required to bring/use your own computer and any software or other hardware required to participate in the [Not Only Game] Jam event.
12. If everyone in your team cannot attend Phase II, an alternative team may be picked by the judging panel instead. You shall let us know if you or any member of your team cannot attend Phase II.
13. We do not accept responsibility for entries that are lost, delayed or which we do not receive.

The prizes and winners

14. There shall be one (1) winning team.
15. The winning team shall be the entry which in the opinion of the judging panel (including an independent member) is in the opinion of the panel, the most creative and interesting towards diversity and inclusion in videogames or new digital entertainment technologies.
16. The prize is 100€ (one hundred euros) Amazon voucher for each member of the winning team.
17. We will notify the winners and hand over the prize after the competition ends on the 13th May 2018.
18. We have the right to substitute any prize for an alternative prize of equal or greater value.
19. Prizes are not transferable and cannot be exchanged for cash or another prize.
20. You may request the last name and country of prize winner(s) by sending an email to competitions@king.com. By entering this competition you give us permission to make your last name and country available in this way if you win.
21. The decision of the judging panel is final. No correspondence will be entered into regarding the selection of the winner of this competition.

About your entry

22. You promise that all of the information which you provide to us in connection with this competition shall be and shall remain complete and accurate.

For other loss or damage we will only be responsible for losses which are a reasonably foreseeable consequence of our negligence or breach of these terms and conditions up to the value of the winning prize.
